 Education researchers in Sub-Saharan Africa (SSA) and the Middle East/North Africa (MENA) to offer them mentorship & research opportunities

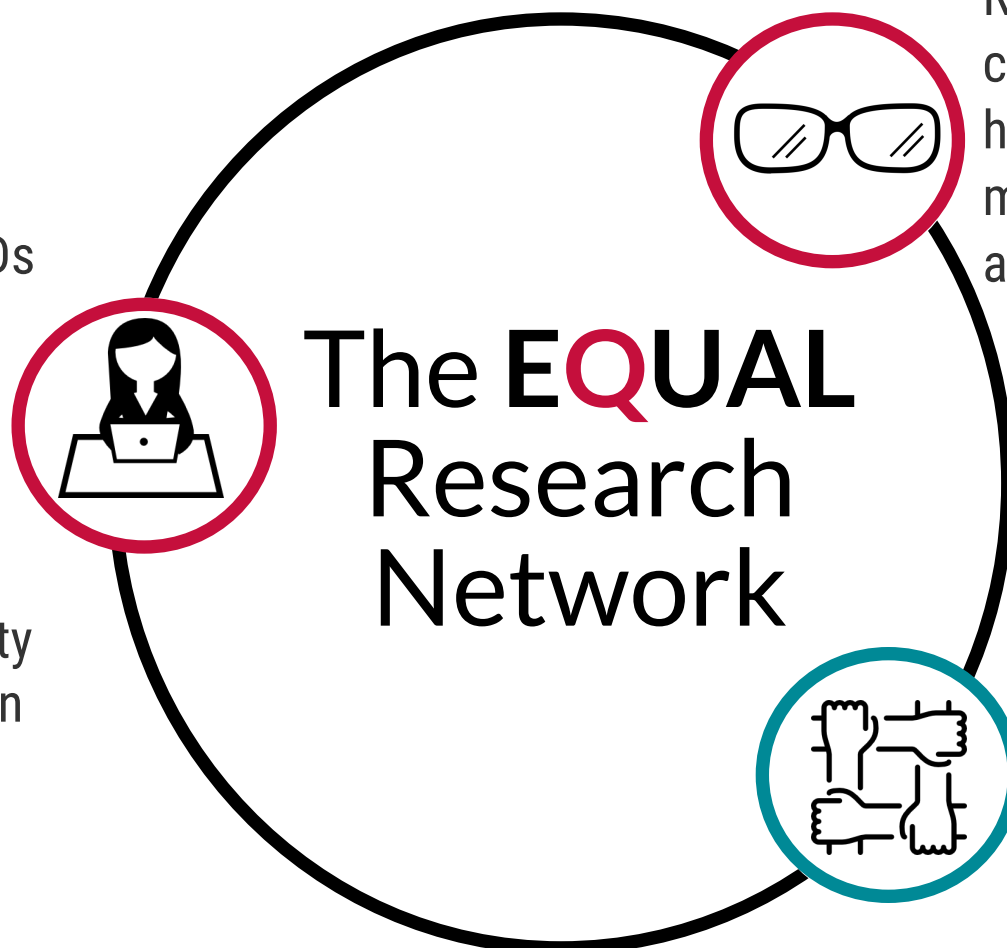
FUND

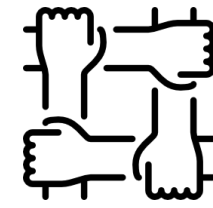
RESEARCHERS
